Building System Legislation Reform Programme

- Report back on Bill due on 4 March
- Once the report is back, we'll start pre-work on the regulations
- Regulations are the real engine room of the MCM scheme – it's where all the details that underpin the scheme are established
- We'll be working closely with stakeholders to develop the Regulations

Other work of interest

- Review of consenting system – this will be a big picture policy review
- We're starting with an information gathering phase – literature review, data analysis, file reviews, workshops
- We'll then move to look at options for change
- It's critical that where we land is targeted at addressing the problems the evidence-gathering phase throws up

A quick update on consenting

- We've put together industry working group, arising out of Accord workstream
- The group will look for way to drive effectiveness and efficiency in consenting – within the confines of the existing regulatory system
- It includes around 15 people from across the building sector
